Within Erasmus+, a training course is a project where youth workers and youth leaders come together for several days to develop their knowledge, skills, and attitudes on a certain theme. The daily programme of the course is based on learning objectives and facilitated by experienced trainers. The training courses promote the initiative and creativity of participants and have a direct impact on their future youth work or youth policy activities, such as organising quality projects and providing intercultural and non-formal learning experiences for young people.

Altogether, **29** people took part in the project.

The overall aim and specific objectives of the project:

The Training Course was an integral part of the multi-stage project "Support Programme for Youth "Online Career". TC was aimed to train youth workers — representatives of 8 partner organisations — to become coaches and mentors for young people in their career building on the online job market. Participants learned about the online course "Online Career" and how they can use it online and live.

Main contents and activities of the project:

1. Getting-to-know each other, integration and building common ground.
2. Contextual part: participants received theoretical and practical information about youth unemployment in Europe; learned about mentoring and coaching approaches.
3. Practical part: participants learned about the online course and planed their future local activities.
4. Evaluation of the learning process of participants: reflection groups, YouthPass.
5. Evaluation of the training course.
